

Announcing... the Clubmans Track Day Mallory Park - Thursday 25th March 2004

Slicks and wings and... you!

Here's a unique opportunity to test a MG XPOWER Clubmans or Classic Clubmans car on a race circuit. Even if you do not have a racing licence¹ you can get a feel for the roadholding and fun that makes Clubmans the most accessible and entertaining racing in the UK... from the driver's point of view.

At the request of many drivers keen to race Clubmans racing cars, the Clubmans Register has organised a track day again, on Thursday 25th March. The event is primarily for existing members who will be bringing their cars for testing and to provide drives to their own guests. But the event is also to encourage new drivers into the Clubmans formulæ.

The Register will charge £100 per driver for 2 sessions of 15 minutes in a selection of cars available on the day. Only those cars to which you are allocated are insured against damage on the track, so we do advise you to follow the guidance of the Clubmans Register member who will be looking after you. Also, the owner of the car giving you the drive gets a small subsidy from the Clubmans Register so please make sure to give the owner the voucher entitling you to the drive. The sessions might vary in length and we will do everything possible to give each driver choice of cars and maximum track time. Subject to time and demand, each driver can purchase additional sessions @£60 per 15-20 minute session during the day. By the way, this compares with £50 for just five laps at the Thruxton school.

The cars available to you have a 1 in the Guest column "G". You can express your preference and we'll do our best to accommodate you.

To complete the arrangements we now need a cheque for £100 from you, and the form filled out if you have not already done so. Send the attached form and cheque (made payable to the Clubmans Register) to Marcus Bicknell (who is supporting the effort to recruit new drivers to Classic and MG XPower Clubmans) at the address on the form.

- 1) Motor Racing is dangerous. The Clubmans Register accepts no liability in respect of accidents or incidents at the track day but has satisfied itself that third party liability insurance is in place.
- 2) The Clubmans Register or the car owner will insure damage incurred by those cars made available for drivers at the Track Day on the basis on the basis that the driver pays half the excess in the event of an accident requiring substantive repairs. The excess will be £500 unless otherwise communicated in writing to the driver.
- 3) A valid UK driving license or an MSA competition licence is required by the Track Day organisers.
